



Yealm Medical Centre prescription pick up – Thanks to all the volunteers!

Working closely with Yealm Medical Centre three named volunteers will pick up and deliver Brixton prescriptions, observing confidentiality/GDPR. We aim for Tuesday and Thursday, after 5pm.

Ask everyone you know to email e.yealmmedicalcentre@nhs.net with prescription requests at least 6 working days ahead, but no more than two weeks ahead. Just name, address and medication are needed in the email to the Yealm Medical Centre. They can only dispense 28 days of meds, so plan ahead! It's important for them to minimise crowds, contacts and risks.

We must have people's permission to collect their meds – those who have already done this are on the list. To be added for pick up, email helen.deaswilliams@brixtonparishcouncil.org.uk (don't use Messenger for this) or phone 01752 881873 so we can add them.

We just need the NAME they are KNOWN BY at the Yealm Medical Centre – may be different from daily use name - full address and phone number. We don't want to know about their medication, just date due. Also, whether they are exempt or pay for prescriptions (awaiting Yealm Medical Centre advice on payment for those who pay).

We can only pick up for those who have asked us. If going there, it's closed between 1-2pm.
